HOW TO SIGN UP

1. Pick several dates from the trip schedule and call the office at 800-786-7238 to check availability and reserve your spot(s).
2. Alternatively, place your name on a waitlist (no charge) because people frequently cancel or change their date.
3. Send a non-refundable \$250 deposit per person for individual reservations, or a non-refundable \$400 deposit per person for group reservations to our office within 10 days of making a reservation. A group reservation is defined as 10 or more spaces on the trip.

CANCELLATION / REFUND POLICY: All payments are refundable until 120 days prior to your trip date, less the \$250 or \$400 per person deposit, which is non-refundable. **NO refunds are available after the 120 day deadline.** We strongly recommend you purchase trip insurance. A one dollar per day contribution is "passed through" from your fare directly to conservation groups and other environmental organizations working to protect the Grand Canyon. Funding support is also provided to non-profit organizations working to enhance access to Grand Canyon River trips for persons with disabilities. If you elect not to participate in this, simply deduct the amount from your fare.

SPECIALTY TRIPS

Natural History Discovery: Spend 10 days with our experienced crew and a regional expert as you explore and learn with special emphasis on the natural history of the Grand Canyon. Topics include geology, origins, botany, climate and environmental impact of the Glen Canyon Dam. You will also receive four Grand Canyon guidebooks.

Stories of the Grand Canyon Discovery: The stories of the Grand Canyon are outrageous, from the fated Hyde honeymoon to John Wesley Powell's maiden voyage. This hybrid trip will have a crew that is particularly well versed in European history of the Grand Canyon, in addition to a trip historian, Brad Dimock, who has spent thirty years as a guide in Grand Canyon and rivers around the world.

Motor/Kayak with Otter Bar: This trip offers complete raft support for kayakers. Kayakers must have solid Class 3+ paddling skills and a bomb-proof roll. Guides will help you pick your lines, however, this is not an instructional trip. Non-kayakers are welcomed and may ride in one of the motorized support rafts. Contact Otter Bar Lodge Kayak School directly at (530) 462-4772 to book.

Hiker's Discovery: This trip is designed for hiking enthusiasts. This non-motorized adventure allows for ample time to explore many side canyons as you raft down the river, some of which we may visit only once or twice all season. Sixteen days in the Canyon is a treat but if you don't have the time, you may also choose to do the 7-day upper canyon or the 10-day lower canyon.

This service is operated by Arizona Raft Adventures and Grand Canyon Discovery, Concessioners under contract with the U.S. Government and administered by the National Park Service. The Concessioners are responsible for conducting these operations in a satisfactory manner. Prices are approved by the National Park Service.
